- Sullen or depressed behavior from an otherwise friendly and positive person
- Out-of-context outbursts of verbal or physical aggression
- · Increased levels of agitation, frustration and anger
- Confrontational, accusatory or blaming behavior
- An unusual interest in or fascination with weapons
- Fixation on violence as a means of addressing a grievance
- Aggression toward animals

THREATS:

- Threats whether real or intended as a prank require the mobilization of significant resources, potentially endanger lives and often carry life-altering consequences for the offender.
- Even a prank threat against a school or public place is considered a federal crime.
- Offenders will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law. It can lead to a felony that carries a maximum sentence of five years in prison.
- Remind your children to think before they act.
